

The CWL's own Ellie Eddner sat down with CWL Commissioner Samantha Solie and CWL owner Lazarus Lane.



Any CWL fan instantly recognizes this as the Arabian Regional title.)

PP: Hello everyone, and welcome to "Primetime Parlay" with Pam Paulshock! Today I have a brand new guest, a man who has started to make some waves in the CWL, the current Arabian champion, Mike "Freaking" Mason. Mike, welcome to the show.

PP: Do you have any opinion on Barry's political views?

MM: *(Mason scowls, beginning to look agitated again.)* His political views have nothing to do with his wrestling ability.

PP: Moving right along... **Fabulous Harry Hurt.**

MASON ENTERPRISES



MM: A man unprepared for the position he's been put in as World Champion, if that press conference debacle is any indication. A lackluster wrestler, with a lackluster career, who won a prestigious title in a lackluster match. He won't last long if I have anything to say about it.

PP: Maybe the fans will be treated to a showdown between you two. Alright, last one... **Alec Von Snapp!**

MM: What a waste!

PP: Wha-

MM: What a complete waste of talent! He has every tool to be the future of the entire IWAR.

PP: It sounds like you respect him? I thought you hated Alec Von Snapp.

MM: Respect, even grudging respect, is just the finely honed edge of the blade that is hatred. I hate him because he could be SO much more than he is now! Instead of focusing on his own career, he chooses to worry more about whether he lives up to the image of his father, or his brothers. Whether or not he fits the "Von Snapp mold". And worst of all, he worries about what all of YOU think of him. Your cheers and boos don't make a man any more or less talented than he already is. Because of that, he's wallowing as part of a Six-man team, or Trios, or whatever you want to call them, instead of being the main event champion he ought to be! It makes me sick just thinking about it! We're done here, I have a match to get ready for.

(Mason stands abruptly, clawing at the mic clipped to his shirt.) Who's producing this segment? You! Get over her and get this D**** thing off me!

PP: This was another edition of "Primetime Parlay" with Pam Paulshock. Back to you guys at ringside.

(Camera cuts to black)

THE SYNDICATE




Ellie Eddner stands in the backstage area, anxiously awaiting **"The Major" Bennie Factor** to exit the arena proper after his match. The pipe and draping fixtures erected to cordone this space off shrouds the lighting, giving the area a shadowed aura. Since her range of sight is obscured by the heavy black curtains, Ellie closes her eyes to focus on the raucous cheering of the crowd. The various aromas of popcorn, beer, hotdogs, and sweat all mingling together into one bouquet that belongs in only one place... a wrestling arena.

It is as Ellie is taking in this blind atmosphere of smells and sounds that she hears thousands of voices crying out as one single entity. ONE... TWO... THREE!! The clarion call of the bell at ringside rises above the din three times signalling the end of the match. It isn't long before Ellie's chosen target ambles through the curtain. Though Bennie Factor is glistening with sweat, his breathing is hardly close to 'labored', despite the physical exertion he must have gone through. As Factor steps forward (*adjusting the CWL Tag Team Championship and Amazon Basin championship belts over his shoulders*) intending to head to the showers, Ellie moves to intercept "The Major". It is then that she notices two masked figures, their black clothing acting as makeshift camouflage amid the sable curtaining, emerge from the shadowy surroundings. Future Man: *Pew pew pew!*


