

Whereas, a match featuring Demolition Crew defending their CWL World tag team titles against Millennial Reign would be best for business;

Therefore, it is ordered that Demolition Crew shall defend their CWL World tag team titles against Millennial Reign at Executive Order.



Executive Order 004-Setting Match for Internet Title

Whereas, Double D Christoph finished second in the Brawl For It All, and
Whereas, Double D Christoph earned a shot at the Internet title, and
Whereas, RFD: Battle Axe defeated Logan Kane for the Internet title;
Therefore, it is ordered that RFD: Battle Axe shall defend the CWL Internet title against Double D. Christoph at Executive Order.

Executive Order 005-Setting Match for Six-Man Tag Titles

Whereas, the Nutty Bunnies have dominated the Six-Man Tag scene the last several cycles; and

Whereas, the fans are tired of seeing the Nutty Bunnies face The Von Snapps and the Immortal Dynasty, and

Whereas, in their debut cycle, R2: Saguaro Shane LeBlanc, Apache Aaron LeBlanc, & Pinnacle Pete LeBlanc wrestler the Nutty Bunnies to a draw,

Therefore, it is ordered that the Nutty Bunnies defend the Six-Man Tag titles against R2: Saguaro Shane LeBlanc, Apache Aaron LeBlanc, & Pinnacle Pete LeBlanc at Executive Order. However, in the event that the challengers do not trash talk between now and then, they will be stripped of their title match.

Executive Order 006-Setting #1 Contender Match for World Title

It is ordered that there will be a #1 Contender match for the CWL World title match. It will be a War Games submit or surrender match featuring the wrestlers who won (and will win) the CWL League title from Cycles 332 through 338 and who trash talk. These wrestlers presently include the American Patriot, Norman "the Loon" Kevcus, RFD: Midnight Scorpion, and "Late Night" Logan Kane. The winner will receive a title shot at the third pay-per-view of the year.

Executive Order 007-Setting #1 Contender Match for Internet Title

It is ordered that all TV title holders from Cycles 332 through 338 who trash talk will be entered into a Beat the Clock Challenge to determine the #1 Contender to the CWL Internet title match. Six wrestlers will face off in three matches. The two wrestlers who beat their opponents the fastest will face off in a match to determine the #1 Contender match for the Internet title at the third pay-per-view of the year.

Executive Order 008-Setting Match for CWL World Title

"Late Night" Logan Kane dominated the CWL and the entire IWA last cycle. Therefore, he has earned a shot at "Nature Boy" Phil Lander's CWL World title. It is ordered that Logan Kane will face Phil Landers at Executive Order for the CWL World Title.



- 4) Challengers to the CWL Tag titles and Six-Man titles are determined at the commissioner's discretion. Factors taken into consideration are trash talk, League and TV titles, and overall rankings for the year.
- 5) Unless otherwise announced, the wrestler with the highest score wins the title. In the event of a tie, the match is considered a draw and the challenger will be a part of the title match at the next pay-per-view.
