<u>T-Money:</u> Hey fellas. I was watching the show. Which was great by the way. I wanted to come by and tell everyone at home the news. Commissioner Jaxx and I have worked together on a deal for those who purchase the Flashback PPV. You will get Boiling Point FREE on us. That's right. The NPL and The Big Ticket is paying for your PPV purchase. And you get an exclusive NPL Flashback Playas Club T-shirt. As of right now, Flashback has the highest purchased PPV buys of ANY PPV in NPL history!

(All the announcers clap and congratulate T-Money, except Bob Sapp.)

<u>Juice:</u> Bob? That's incredibly gracious of the champion. You still aren't convinced?

(T-Money comes over and puts his arm around Bob Sapp. Bob is uncomfortable with this...)

<u>T-Money:</u> Bobby...I know you don't like me. I get it. I WAS a scumbag. Commissioner Jaxx and I have patched things up. We did business. And that benefits all of us. I know you liked the food. You enjoyed the bathrooms. Every stall has a bidet toilet. The connecting hotel is even nicer. Parking is paid for. (*T turns to the commentators.*) And for New York that isn't easy to come by. (*T straightens Bob's tie and collar.*) And this very nice suit...

Bob: My wife bought this for me...

T-Money: oh no, no, noooo Bobby. I purchased this suit and sent it to your home. The lengths I will go to extend this olive branch.

<u>Bob:</u> It isn't about money, Mr. T-Money. You have been gracious. I appreciate the suit and other gifts. You may not be a scumbag, but your true colors always reveal themselves. You can throw money at all these people, but tigers don't change their stripes overnight.

(Card 27: Held in New Orleans, LA. Around the mid-card, Davy Blossom and his valet, Elegance come to the ring. She's dressed in a slim red dress, and he is in a dapper suit. The arena boos as he takes the mic.)

Elegance: (Long pause as the fans boo her. She looks disgusted.) This town is the most disgusting place Davy, and I have EVER been! (Fans Boo) It stinks of the Gulf of Mexico! (Fans boo more) Quiet down you neanderthals and listen to Davy...

<u>Davy Blossom:</u> (Stern look.) Elegance...I am very surprised by what you just said. (Pauses...Elegance looks down in shame.) This is a prideful city! A hardworking, blue-collar town! Survivors of the worst natural disaster in American history. Hurricane Katrina devastated this place. (Pauses) They don't come from the life we do. They're poor and cannot help that. (Fans boo as Davy smiles.) I mean come on...you people remind me of the loser Malcolm Mack is. He has nothing. He won't amount to anything. AND he will never defeat me in this ring. (The Fans chant "We want Malcolm" repeatedly.) Challenging me was the worst mistake he has ever made. When he blew that cigar smoke in my Elegance's face he crossed a line. I do not...

(Elegance taps Davy a few times to alert him that Lincoln Mack was coming to the ring. Lincoln grabs a mic and speaks.)

Lincoln Mack: I think the great people of New Orleans has heard enough from you sir. (*Fans Cheer!*) It's one thing to run down my hometown, but now you speak down to MY son? No. I will give it to you Davy and Elegance. You both have come from a privilege life. I'm sure you have maids, gardeners, assistance, etc.

<u>Davy:</u> (Smiles) We do actually.


<u>Malcolm:</u> DAVY!!! I'm going to take everything from you! At Flashback you are getting smoked!
