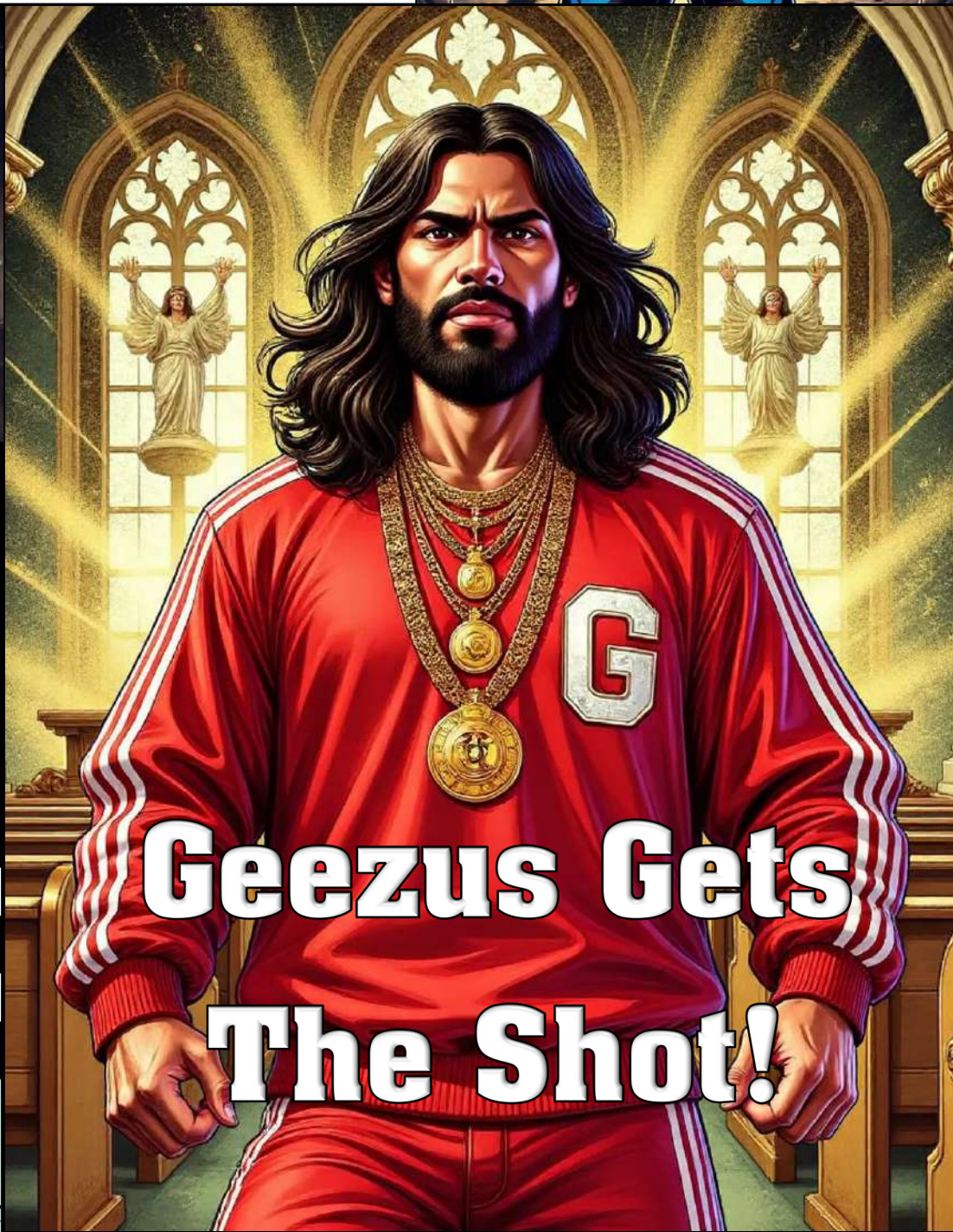

Dr. George Zahorian II – NWL Physician

A former Willowick, Ohio gynecologist with a history of dispensing anabolic steroids, Dr. Zahorian spent years in prison for his controversial medical practices. Luthor brought him back as the NWL physician, where he now works in the Asylum's dungeon, creating "supplements" for wrestlers. Known for his questionable ethics, he prioritizes money and ego over patient care.

Tito Santana – NWL Trainer

A respected veteran, Tito brings class, experience, and integrity to the NWL. Outside wrestling, he's known as a trainer at the National Wrestling League. Luthor respects him enough to make him a trainer for the NWL, where he teaches with dignity and a strong sense of professionalism.

Manny Davis – NWL Head Referee

A disgraced former referee, Manny has a history of match-fixing and unethical behavior. Known for his shady background, including stealing the original IWA Championship belt and making false accusations, he was ultimately brought back to the NWL as head referee after Luthor and Jack Cornette discovered him refereeing underground bum fights. Cornette explained, "Luthor believes in second chances."

Alexa Ivory – AI

I sent him a dozen dead roses and a card that said "GET WELL NEVER."

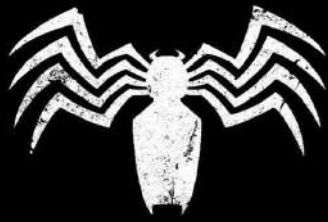
When you run your mouth like a lawn mower, eventually someone's gonna cut the cord—and Rusty Chains was just the guy for the job.

That's it for now. Get your tickets to Rumble in the Bronx or don't bother showin' your face around here again.

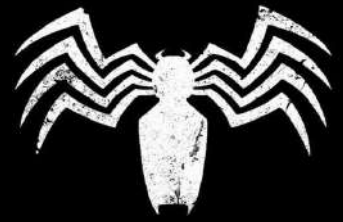

(DRAGON SLEEPER/LEG SCISSORS COMBO)**

CATCHPHRASE: "GOT IT? YOU DAMN WELL BETTER!"

HAILING FROM THE HISTORIC STREETS OF CHESTERTOWN, MARYLAND, "G-FORCE" GARRIE MORRIS IS ONE OF THE MOST CEREBRAL AND COLD-BLOODED TECHNICIANS IN PROFESSIONAL WRESTLING TODAY. BEFORE BEGINNING HIS WRESTLING CAREER, MORRIS WAS A GOLD GLOVES BOXER, FIGHTING AS A SOUTHPAW, HAVING A MEAN LEFT CROSS. BOXING TAUGHT MORRIS TO BE CALM UNDER PRESSURE AND COLD IN HIS PRECISION IN THE WRESTLING WORLD. MORRIS DOESN'T WASTE WORDS OR MOTION—HE LETS HIS ACTIONS SPEAK, AND THEY SPEAK LOUDLY. INSIDE THE RING, HE OPERATES WITH SURGICAL AGGRESSION, ISOLATING A BODY PART AND DISSECTING HIS OPPONENTS WITH METHODOICAL VIOLENCE. THERE ARE NO BREATHERS, NO BREAKS, AND NO SYMPATHY. ONCE THE BELL RINGS, MORRIS LOCKS IN LIKE A MISSILE ON ITS TARGET.

A MASTER STRATEGIST, MORRIS BUILT HIS REPUTATION IN UWN AND WCWF, WHERE HE WAS LOCKED IN BRUTAL WORLD TITLE FEUDS WITH THE LIKES OF GUNSLINGER AND PYROMANIAC—TWO OF THE MOST FEARED NAMES IN THEIR ERA. THOSE WARS HONED MORRIS INTO A CHAMPION-CALIBER COMPETITOR WITH A DEEP PLAYBOOK AND AN EVEN DEEPER MEAN STREAK. HIS FINISHING MOVE TURBULENCE (A FRONT FALLING RUSSIAN LEG SWEEP) IS ONLY PART OF THE EQUATION—HIS DREADED SUBMISSION, THE G-LOCK (A DRAGON SLEEPER COMBINED WITH LEG SCISSORS TO IMMOBILIZE HIS OPPONENT), HAS ENDED MORE CAREERS THAN MOST TOP-ROPE DIVES EVER COULD.

TAG TEAM WRESTLING, HOWEVER, IS WHERE MORRIS HAS BECOME TRULY DANGEROUS. ALONGSIDE LONGTIME PARTNER "THE GREAT ENTERTAINER" BRIAN CLOTHIER, HE FORMS ONE-HALF OF THE MERCILESS DUO KNOWN AS THE MARYLAND MILITIA. THEIR NAME IS MORE THAN JUST BRANDING—IT'S A TRIBUTE TO THE CHESTERTOWN TEA PARTY, A FORGOTTEN ACT OF DEFIANCE THAT MIRRORS THEIR APPROACH IN THE NATIONAL WRESTLING LEAGUE. JUST LIKE THEIR COLONIAL NAMESAKES, THE MARYLAND MILITIA LAUNCHES SUDDEN, CALCULATED ASSAULTS ON THE ESTABLISHMENT, WAGING GUERRILLA WARFARE ON THE TAG DIVISION AND TEARING THROUGH TEAMS WITH UNRELENTING EFFICIENCY.

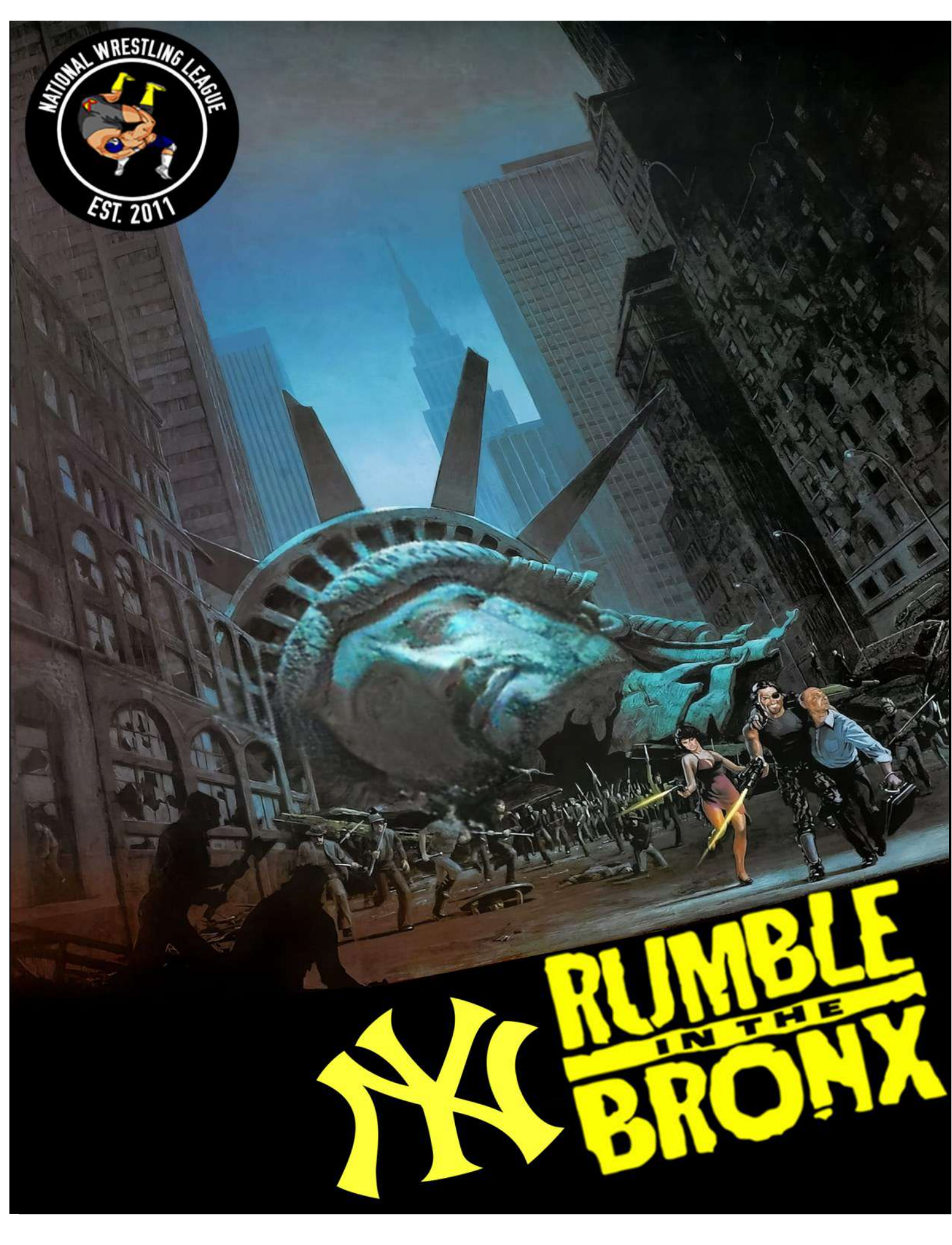
MORRIS IS THE STRATEGIST. CLOTHIER IS THE WILDCARD. ALEXANDER
ALEXANDER SPEAKS

Alexander Asylum King Park NY

I have been inside many wrestling facilities in my time—gyms, arenas, training camps. But nothing prepared me for what awaited me inside the bowels of the Alexander Asylum. From the outside, it looked like a dank, rotting dungeon—the kind of place where secrets are buried and never meant to be uncovered.

But beyond the iron doors, past the heavy security and watchful eyes of Mr. T and Dr. George Zahorian, I found something unexpected. A luxurious apartment. Not just comfortable—extravagant. Marble floors. Velvet furniture. A king's ransom worth of amenities. Dr. Zahorian led me through the halls, his voice carrying an uneasy confidence. "Alexander Alexander is dangerous," he tells me. "He has to be locked up." I ask the obvious question. "Is it true that Alexander Alexander is a clone?" Dr. Zahorian hesitates. "I don't really know. But where Luthor Alexander is involved?" He smirks. "Anything is possible."

I am led to a special interview room—the kind you see in crime dramas. A thick, bulletproof glass wall separates us. A two-way speaker sits between us. And behind the glass? Alexander Alexander. For two hours, he just stares at me. Never speaking. Never blinking. Occasionally, he sings to himself in Russian. I do not recognize the song, but it chills me to my core. Then—finally—he speaks. His voice is deep, heavy, thick with a Russian accent. "Why have you come?"

The first thing I notice—his accent. Luthor Alexander has no accent. The second thing—his eyes. Luthor's eyes are brown. Alexander's? Icy blue. Physically, they are identical. And yet, for years, people have debated whether Alexander Alexander is just another one of Luthor's elaborate mind games. After all, no one has ever seen them together. Not in pictures. Not in videos. Not even in childhood records. The only time Alexander Alexander ever appeared in wrestling was a brief, horrifying run in the CWL—a run so violent and disturbing that all records were sealed. Whatever he did, it forced Luthor to lock him away. I lean forward, trying to get a read on him. "I just want to get to know you." Alexander taps his fingers against the glass. A rhythmic beat. It takes me a second to recognize it. Morse code. .. / .- .. .-.. .-.. / -.- .. .-.. .-.. / -.- --- ..- "I WILL KILL YOU." Then, without warning, he starts singing again.

I go for the big question. "Are you the Red Scorpion?" The moment the words leave my lips, he snaps. He launches himself at the glass, fists pounding. Screaming. His entire body shakes with rage. Five orderlies rush in. They try to subdue him—but he fights them off. His shirt rips away in the chaos, exposing his bare chest. And that's when I see it. A scorpion. Branded into his back. Dr. Zahorian slips behind him and injects something into his neck. A moment later—Alexander Alexander collapses.

I stand frozen, staring at his unconscious body. That scorpion mark. It should mean something. It should be a clue. But in my gut, I feel like I'm missing the bigger picture. I exhale, turn away, and tell myself to move on. But as I leave the Alexander Asylum, I can't shake one thought. What if he isn't the Red Scorpion? What if he's something worse? Oh hey a zoo !





[Camera pans across Luthor Alexander's office, walls lined with dusty NWL artifacts, old blood-spattered posters, and faded title belts. Behind a grand desk sits LUTHOR ALEXANDER—composed, calculating, the architect of the madness. Opposite him, lounging like he owns the room, is “G-FORCE” GARRIE MORRIS. Black bomber jacket zipped halfway. Aviators on. Leaning back in his chair opposing the NWL Commissioner. The picture of relaxed danger.]

LUTHOR ALEXANDER (measured, with a faint smirk): "You and I... we speak the same language, Garrie. We don't crave order. We crave impact. Shockwaves. Chaos isn't the problem—it's the currency."

[He gestures vaguely to a file on the desk labeled “Clothier.”]

*"But your partner... **Brian Clothier**. He's... off-script. He's handing out pink slips like he owns the payroll. Turning my asylum into a boardroom. SAYING I'M GOING TO PAY!"*

[G-Force doesn't react immediately. He slowly removes his aviators, folds them, and tucks them into his jacket.]

Garrie Morris (cool, confident): "First mistake, Luthor... thinking any of this wasn't part of THE plan."

[He leans in slightly, voice steady.]

"Clothier did exactly what we needed him to do. He rattled cages. Slashed dead weight. Pissed off the fanbase. All of it—noise. Beautiful... strategic... noise."

[Luthor raises an eyebrow, intrigued. Morris stands up slowly, pacing as he talks.]

*"You think we did all that for kicks? Nah. We wanted your attention. We wanted to see if the man behind the curtain was still pulling the strings... or if he was just another relic nailed to the walls of this haunted museum you call an office. We HAD TO KNOW if there were any remnants of **Revolution Extreme** hiding in there."*

[He stops, turning toward Alexander with a grin. Alexander appears annoyed but intrigued with the mention of his former stable.]

"You passed the test. Especially with your contributions to Make-A-Wish at Homecoming!"

[Alexander cracks a slight smile thinking of the Soviet Superkick, before getting serious again.]

LUTHOR ALEXANDER: "So what now? You planning to reel him in? Put a leash on the suit before he steps on the wrong set of toes?!"

[G-Force's smile fades just enough to show teeth. Serious now.]

*Garrie Morris: "I'll somewhat contain him. I'll in the least steer him away from you and your payroll that you don't want CUT. Clothier listens to me because I don't feed him nonsense. I tell him what wins. And right now? Aligning with you? That's the win. But I assure you, you DO NOT want him fully contained. You said it yourself, Chaos is currency... **And Clothier equals Chaos.**"*

[He walks to the desk and places both hands on it, looming just enough to show dominance—but not disrespect.]

"But just so we're clear... if I'm keeping him in check, I expect something in return."

[Alexander studies him for a beat. Then smiles.]

LUTHOR ALEXANDER (amused): "I figured you would."

[G-Force leans in slightly, voice just above a whisper.]

Garrie Morris: "You don't need to know what it is. YET."

LUTHOR ALEXANDER (back to serious): "Depending on what you are asking, I might need more in return."

Garrie Morris (amused): "I figured you would say that as well."

[He turns and walks toward the door, then pauses, looking over his shoulder.]

"What do you have in mind?"

[Morris closes the door before the segment can reveal to "G-Force" what additional task Luthor Alexander has for him and "The Great Entertainer" Brian Clothier.]



[CAMERA OPENS on ringside during a lull. Suddenly, a hand slaps over the barricade. Then a knee. Then the entire body of a confused, clumsy, round man awkwardly topples over it with a loud *THUD*. Security doesn't move. The crowd is baffled.]

Lance Catamaran (off-mic):
"...Who IS that?"

[The man—sweaty, winded, and holding a half-crushed soda—grabs a folding chair, drags it toward the ring, sets it up backwards, and flops down into it like he just ran a marathon. He has a microphone. Somehow.]

THE FAN: *panting* “Okay... whew... time out. Lemme... just catch my breath here. That barricade’s got more hops than I do...”

[He wipes his forehead with a Pokémon towel. The crowd starts chuckling.]

THE FAN: “You’re probably wondering who I am. Well, lemme introduce myself before security figures it out. I’m the fan that Brian Clothier *fired* at Homecoming. That’s right—I’m the guy he humiliated, tossed out like expired cheese at a corporate potluck. My name is MARK BOTCH”

[A few people cheer.]

MARK “THE FAN” BOTCH: “But I didn’t go back to my mom’s basement and sulk—okay, I *did* go back to the basement, but that’s where I do my best thinking! I got my weight bench down there. I mean, it’s mostly used to hang laundry on, but STILL!”

[He slowly, very slowly, stands up. Dramatic pause. A drumroll from a nearby fan.]

MARK “THE FAN” BOTCH:

“I’m gonna climb the corporate ladder... *one... rung... at a time!*

I’m gonna train... eventually!

I’m gonna say my prayers—well, mostly for snacks to be on sale!

And I’m takin’ my vitamins—*gummy* ones, baby!”

“And one day, I’m not just gonna be the greatest FAN the NWL ever had... I’m gonna be the greatest CHAMPION. One cheeseburger... and one soda... at a time.”

[Crowd POPS. “BOTCH! BOTCH! BOTCH!” chant starts.]

MARK “THE FAN” BOTCH: “So Brian Clothier, Mr. Money Train, Mr. Pink Slip—consider this your notice! Because I’m not just here to cheer from the sidelines anymore... I’m here to BOTCH my way straight to the main event! It doesn’t matter if I have to go through you, or anyone else.”

[He points to the hard cam. Then second guesses himself and points to a different camera. Then back again.]

MARK “THE FAN” BOTCH: “You can’t get rid of me, bro. But I’m like that one pop-up ad that just keeps coming back!”

[He raises a fist triumphantly. Then tries to climb into the ring... and gets stuck halfway over the bottom rope.]

MARK “THE FAN” BOTCH: “...Okay hang on, just gotta... scoot a bit... annnnd—”

[He falls face-first into the ring with a *thud*. Crowd loses it.]

[BACKSTAGE - PRIVATE DRESSING ROOM AREA]

*(The camera fades in on a private area backstage, dimly lit, slick with the cold blue light of flickering monitors. The Maryland Militia's insignia hangs in the background—bold letters in military stencil style. Standing in front of it, dressed in his signature black and blue tuxedo-style ring gear, is **Brian Clothier—The Great Entertainer**. Next to him, arms crossed and rocking mirrored aviators, stands **G-Force Garrie Morris**, flexing and nodding along as Clothier paces.)*

The Great Entertainer (Brian Clothier): *"You feel that, Garrie? You feel that hum in the walls? That low murmur in the pipes? That's the sound of a **machine breaking down**—the sound of the **NWL falling apart**, piece by miserable piece."*

(He stops and faces the camera, intense.)

*"And I say... **let it**. Because we're not here to fix this mess. We're here to **rebuild it in our image**. The **Maryland Militia** isn't just a team—we **are the architects of a hostile takeover**. And the first step? Excising the **overpaid, underachieving, locker-room-squatting** so-called 'talent' that's been dragging this promotion into the red for **years**."*

G-Force Garrie Morris: *(Chuckling, he slaps Clothier on the back.)*

*"Man, we're not just cleaning house—we're razing the whole foundation. **Pink Slips** for every last one of 'em. Anyone not pullin' their weight? **Gone**. You, me—we're the last real earners left. And I say we don't stop there..."*

(He lowers his sunglasses, dead serious now.)

*"We bring **Commissioner Luthor Alexander** into the fold. You know he's not blind to what's goin' on. He' loves the sound of chaos with a purpose. I'm sure he's just as sick of the clowns running the show. If we make him **an offer he can't ignore**? We won't just run the ring—we'll run the boardroom."*

The Great Entertainer (Brian Clothier): *(Smiling now, slow and menacing.)*

*"Luthor Alexander... the last suit with a spine. I like it. Let's make the offer. Let's give him a **vision**—a company of killers, not comedians. A promotion where excellence is the floor, not the ceiling."*

(He turns, looks dead into the camera lens.)

*"It's already begun. One by one, we're handing out **Pink Slips**, and believe me—when I hit 'em with **mine**, they don't need to be fired—they'll **quit**. And when the dust settles... only the elite will be left standing. Only the **money men**. Only the **Maryland Militia**."*

(He points at the lens.)

"I AM the Engineer of the Money Train. I AM the One the fans come to see. And I WILL return this company to its former glory—even if I have to burn it down first."

(Without missing a beat, Clothier tosses his jacket over his shoulder and strides out of frame. The camera follows him from behind as he moves with purpose through the concrete backstage corridors. Crew members part like the Red Sea. Gorilla position techs turn in their seats. He walks past monitors showing the live crowd, never once looking back.)

*(Just before stepping through the curtain, the **opening chords of "Bodies" by Drowning Pool** begin to build. Blue strobe lights flash through the curtain slit.)*

“LET THE BODIES HIT THE FLOOR!”

*(As the bass drops, Clothier bursts through the curtain to a **frenzy of boos and scattered cheers**. The Jumbotron explodes with glitchy, corporate-style visuals—spreadsheets burning, pink slips raining, the Maryland Militia logo stamped over fallen wrestlers. Pyro erupts in cold blue streaks and silver rain. Clothier throws his arms out wide as if embracing the chaos, lips curled in a satisfied sneer. He marches to the ring like he owns it—because in his mind... he already does.)*

*(The music fades. The crowd is on fire—booing relentlessly, a few fans in the front row defiantly holding up Maryland Militia signs. In the ring, **Brian Clothier** stands tall, Mid-Atlantic Championship draped over one shoulder, microphone in hand, eyes scanning the arena with smug contempt.)*

The Great Entertainer (Brian Clothier): *"Do you hear that? That's the sound of **silence**. That's the sound of fear. That's the sound of every so-called 'champion' in the NWL **realizing their time is up**."*

(Crowd erupts into boos. He lets them rain down, unfazed.)

*"In **just two months**, I did what most of these lifetime curtain-jerkers **couldn't do in ten years**—I walked into the NWL, won **two titles**, and turned this place into a **hostile work environment** for everyone collecting a check they didn't earn!"*

(He paces the ring with purpose, holding the belt high.)

*"Scapegoat? **Gone**. Kamikaze? **Ran off like the spineless ghost he is**. You're welcome. The **Maryland Militia**, we didn't even lay a hand on them—but, we did make them rethink their careers. We made them **vanish**. That's what happens when you're exposed by the future of this business. When you're handed a **PINK SLIP**."*

(He sneers at the hard cam.)

*"And let me make something real clear—this **Mid-Atlantic Championship**? It's finally where it belongs. **In the hands of someone who's FROM the Mid-Atlantic**. A true **Maryland-born**, bred-for-glory, blue-collar superstar. **A real hero**. Not a tourist, not a flavor of the month. **Me**."*

(The boos intensify—he smiles wider.)

*"Now, all you **pretend champions**, all you charity-case title holders with your fan-voted charisma and corporate protection plans—**you're on notice**. Because sooner or later, you're getting hit with a **Pink Slip**, and you won't need to be fired... you'll **quit**."*

(He turns toward the ramp, staring down the camera.)

*"And as for **Bullman Bolt** and his little group of gum-smacking, gear-carrying, rent-a-friend **jobbers**—you call yourselves the **No-Win Organization**? Fitting name. Because you're not gonna see a win if you're planning on standing in our path! Prepare to take more "L's!"*

*"You are **exactly** the kind of **trash** we came to eliminate. We're not just here to wrestle. We're not just here to win. **We're here to clean house**. And the Maryland Militia doesn't take prisoners—we take over."*

(He steps to the ropes, leaning forward as the crowd gets louder, mic raised like a dagger.)

"I AM the Engineer of the Money Train! I AM the One the fans come to see! I AM the Great Entertainer, and I AM TAKING OVER! Believe it, SUCKERS!"

*(He drops the mic with a metallic thud as "Bodies" by Drowning Pool hits again. Clothier raises his arms high, the championship gleaming under the lights as pyro blasts from the corners. The camera lingers on his smug face while **Catamaran** and **Roulette** silently begin to think about the chaos he's bringing to the NWL.)*



[Scene: A dark, empty wrestling arena. The American flag hangs behind El Luchador Americano. He stands center stage, his mask pristine but his eyes burning with fury. He holds a battered, empty whiskey bottle in one hand, the remnants of maple syrup still staining his shoulder. The air is thick with intensity.]

El Luchador Americano:

“Magnum T’ Eh... you think you broke me? You think hitting me with this bottle was enough to shatter the spirit of El Luchador Americano? You think pouring syrup on me is some kind of insult? Nah. All you did was sweeten the deal, amigo.”

“You trashed my country. You mocked everything I stand for. But you forgot one thing... this flag behind me? It doesn’t break. It doesn’t bend. And neither do I. You see, America isn’t just stars and stripes. It’s grit. It’s heart. It’s fighting when you’re knocked down and standing when the world says stay down.”

“You hit me with whiskey? I’ll hit you with justice. You poured syrup on me? I’ll pour out my soul in that ring. Because this fight isn’t about me. It’s about every man, woman, and child who believes in honor, respect, and freedom. And Magnum... you just declared war on all of it.”

“So bring your bottle. Bring your insults. Bring your syrup. I’ll bring the fight. And when it’s over, you’ll realize one thing. You can try to stain the red, white, and blue... but you can never break it.”

“By the way, I thought your van could use a little American flair. Hope you like it”

□ *[Backstage area, camera zooms in on a hyperventilating interviewer. La Chillindrina is bouncing side to side with the title on her shoulder, while Supa Mickamus is mid-cartwheel with his shades slightly cracked and a wild grin on his face. They're bruised up, sweating buckets, and still RIDING that victory high.]*

Todd Okerlund: “L.E. Chillindrina... Supa Mickamus... you just shocked the world AGAIN by retaining the NWL National Tag Team Titles against the veteran juggernauts of the CWO. Everyone counted you out. How are you feeling right now?!”

L.E. Chillindrina: *[screaming into the mic like it's a karaoke night]*
“WOOOOOOOOOOO!! SOMEBODY CALL SECURITY 'CAUSE WE JUST STOLE THE SHOW AGAIN, BAYBEE!!”

Supa Mickamus hands her a pair of glittery shades. She puts them on upside-down.

Supa Mickamus:
“Ayo, CWO showed up like they was at a reunion tour—washed up, warmed over, and walkin’ real slow. And WE? We was dancin’ on that canvas like it was the Freakin’ Fourth of July!”

Chillindrina:
“I told y’all once and I’ll tell ya again—WE NOT A FLUKE, WE A WHOLE WAVE!
And the Fish Fam? We swim DEEP! We snack on legends like they lunchables!”

Mickamus: *[leans in cool]*

Chillindrina: *[pointing at the camera, winking]*
“Let this be a lesson to all y’all who thought we were just hype... We the National Tag Champs, and we don’t miss. We hit like a bat outta Taco Tuesday!”

Mickamus:
“And if you *still* got doubts... we’ll slap ‘em out ya ears with another title defense. Anytime, anywhere, baby!”

[Fade out with Chillindrina coughing but raising a defiant finger while laughing through the pain.]

Operation Borscht Bomb



Setting: Pre-match in-ring promo from Dimitry Tokarev & Vladamir Vokov. They're trash-talking the American crowd in heavy accents, waving the Russian flag, calling Chillindrina & Mickamus “soft Western entertainers,” and proclaiming themselves the future of tag team wrestling.

Suddenly...

Cue loud polka music

A **giant inflatable fish** slowly inflates at the top of the ramp. The Russians are confused. The crowd is losing it.

Out pops L.E. Chillindrina in full-on babushka attire—wig, apron, and all—holding a giant wooden spoon like a sword.

She shouts in a horrible fake Russian accent:

“I am Grandmother Fishova! And I come to cook you fools into SOUP!”

BAM! Supa Mickamus zip-lines down from the rafters in full spy gear (with fake mustache and goggles), yelling:

“BORSCHT BOMB INBOUND!”

*He lands, tosses cabbage grenades (rubber cabbages with glitter inside) into the ring. They explode in pink smoke.
Crowd is howling.*

Chillindrina whips off the apron and starts hitting Dimitry with a giant ladle. Supa Mickamus spins Vladamir around with a flying hurricanrana and twerks over him mid-ring.

*Then they duct-tape both of the Russians together inside a **giant fish net**, plant the Tag Titles on their chest, and leave a note that reads:*

“Next time y’all want smoke... bring seasoning.”

– Love, the Fish Fam

Chillindrina mic drops with a final line:

“THE ONLY HAMMERS GETTIN’ SWUNG ARE THESE HIPS, BABY!!”



The Notorious” GeeZuS – Post-NWL Homecoming PPV

[Scene opens with a spotlight on a darkened pulpit. The Notorious GeeZuS stands robed in his signature outfit, mic in hand, head bowed while Supa Mickamus & L.E. La Chillindrina stand to the side. Organ music softly plays.]

GeeZuS:

"Brothers... and sisters...

Wrestling faithful of the NWL...

The *true believers*, and even the *nonbelievers* out there in the cheap seats... I know many of you looked to the heavens this past weekend... and asked yourselves..."

[Raises his head dramatically]

"Where... was The Notorious One? Why wasn't he at Homecoming?"

Pauses. Deep breath.

"And I hear you.

I *feel* you.

But sometimes, beloved... silence is sacred.

And absence... well that? That's divine strategy."

Organ fades. Lighting shifts. He slowly removes the robe, revealing a chain, a fitted EDGE tee, and that glint in his eye that says the sermon's over—now it's real talk time.

GeeZuS (tone shifts, more direct):

"Look...

I ain't gonna spell it all out just yet.

Let's just say some **very important**, very *big-money*, very **EDGE-level** meetings were going down.

Real business. Real power.

I'm talkin' *next-move-is-checkmate* type deals."

GeeZuS (stepping forward, smirking):

"But don't get it twisted.

Just 'cause I wasn't in the building don't mean I ain't know what was goin' down.

See, when I looked at that card, I wasn't worried about my people. Nah.

I knew Chillandrina and Supa Mickamus had it on lock."

Grins.

GeeZuS:

"Y'all thought they needed me? Pshh.

They been ready.

They BEEN puttin' in that grind.

I had no doubts. Tag champs? That was never a question. That was just **destiny catchin' up**."

Pause. Now fully casual, more swagger, voice steady, cocky.

GeeZuS:

"And let me say this for the record...

I ain't gonna apologize for movin' how I move.

When you're building somethin' *bigger than titles*, bigger than the NWL...

Sometimes you gotta miss dinner to prepare the feast."

Leans into the camera, voice low, intense.

"And when that table gets set?

You best believe the Fish Fam eatin' FIRST."

Laughs, then shrugs.

"I'll be back real soon.

And when I am?

Oh man...

The *whole game* about to shift.

Y'all thought Homecoming was big?

You ain't seen nothin' yet."

Throws the mic down, EDGE symbol flashes behind him, and he walks off into the dark, hoodie up.

Magnum T.Eh' is shown climbing off a boat at a remote shipyard in the Gulf of Mexico. He is filthy and his clothes are torn up, but he walks with a simmering rage. He walks up to a bewildered local who is talking on their cell phone and punches them in the face! Magnum picks up the phone, hangs up on the call and then dials a new number. It rings one ans it picked up.

Kim: Thank you for calling the IWA, how may I direct your call?"

Magnum T'Eh'. "You tell them all. You tell Luthor Alexander. You tell Johnny B. You tell Mr. T! I don't care, but I just escaped from a prison in El Salvador! Someone in the NWL tried to take me out with the help of the star spangled goons also known as ICE agents! Well guess what? I fought my way outta there eh! I'm gonna find who set me up in the NWL and when I do, I'll end their careers! And I am not sorry about that! USA? Hawwwwkkkk TUUUU!"

My name is Kerry Garrett. I am young and ready. So, let's get it on. Let's rock and roll, baby. I am ready for you. Are you ready for me?



[As Arcane's music hits, the crowd begins to explode in cheers. Arcane stands in the ring, his posture commanding, his voice steady and deliberate as he raises the microphone. The crowd quiets, hanging on his every word.]

Arcane: "Magnum T-Eh, your performance at Homecoming was a perfect reflection of the nation you represent. Canada—the land of polite smiles masking weak leadership, a country that thrives on bending the rules when the spotlight isn't shining on them. You embody that spirit, Magnum. You didn't win at Homecoming; you schemed, you cheated, and you relied on others to do your dirty work. Just like Canada, you couldn't stand on your own two feet without resorting to underhanded tactics from a foreign investor."

[The crowd erupts in cheers as Arcane paces, his words more determined with every step.]

Arcane: "You smashed a bottle of maple syrup over my head, Magnum. Maple syrup—the very symbol of your nation's sweetness and purity. But just like your victory, it was nothing but a facade. Beneath the surface lies desperation, cowardice, and a complete lack of integrity. You didn't just cheat me; you cheated the fans, the sport, and yourself."

[He pauses, turning to the closest camera with a piercing gaze.]

Arcane: "But let me make one thing clear: I am not like you. I don't need shortcuts, and I certainly don't need to blind-side someone with syrup to prove my worth. I fight with honor, with intelligence, and with the strength of someone who knows what it means to earn his victories. You may have walked out of Homecoming with your hand raised, but the world saw the truth. You are a fraud, Magnum—a fraud hiding behind the flag of a nation that deserves better."

[The crowd roars as Arcane steps closer to the ropes, his voice rising with conviction.]

Arcane: "So enjoy your fleeting moment of triumph, Magnum. Bask in the glory of your hollow victory. Because the next time we meet, there will be no syrup, no Clothier, and no excuses. It will be you and me, one-on-one, and I will expose you for the charlatan you truly are. And when I do, the world will see that Arcane doesn't just fight—Arcane dominates."

[He tosses the microphone to the mat with precision, his music hitting as the crowd chants his name.]





[The crowd buzzes with anticipation as Rusty Chains steps into the ring. He grabs a microphone, his expression a mix of bemusement and intensity as he paces the ring. The audience chants "RUSTY-OH RUSTY CHAI-AINS, RUSTY-OH RUSTY CHAI-AINS!" before quieting to hear his words.]

Rusty Chains: "You know, there's a phrase we've all heard before: 'What doesn't kill you makes you stronger.' And Luthor, I've got to hand it to you—you're doing your best to test that theory. You think throwing me in a match with Dreadnought, Meltzer, and your mystery partner is some kind of punishment? You think Vic Venom, the so-called 'journalist' who's made a career out of running his mouth, was going to be my downfall? Guess again."

[The crowd cheers as Rusty pauses, cracking his knuckles and flashing a sly grin.]

Rusty Chains: "Let's talk about Vic Venom for a second. Vic, you've built a reputation as the guy everyone loves to hate. Your journalism is about as credible as a three-dollar bill...and I love to admit, watching Bullman Bolt grab you and plant you through this mat... well, that was *chef's kiss* on poetic justice. You're slime Vic, and it appears that I'm not the only one who thinks so."

[The crowd roars with laughter and cheers, as Rusty shakes his head with an amused smirk.]

Rusty Chains: "Bullman Bolt, I don't know what's running through your mind, and I don't pretend to. But for one brief moment, we were kindred spirits. You saw the problem, and you didn't waste time talking about it—you acted. That's a trait I can respect. Now, I'm not naïve—I know you've got your own agenda. I know our paths might cross in a very different way soon enough. But for now, I'll say this: Thanks for the assist. It's rare to find someone who gets it, even if only for a moment."

[He steps closer to the ropes, leaning forward to address the camera, his tone turning more serious.]

Rusty Chains: "And as for Luthor, NWL management, or anyone else who's still trying to stack the deck against me—understand this: It doesn't matter who you line up. It doesn't matter how much chaos you throw into the mix. I've proven it time and time again, and I'll prove it again next time. I fight with 'No Excuses'. I win with 'No Excuses'. And there's nothing you can do to stop me."

[Rusty drops the microphone with a sharp thud, his music playing as the crowd explodes in chants of " RUSTY-OH RUSTY CHAI-AINS, RUSTY-OH RUSTY CHAI-AINS!" He raises his fists in victory, nodding to the crowd as he exits the ring.]



#233-LEAGUE TAG-TEAM CHAMPION / TV 6-MAN CHAMPION



[The lights in the arena flicker as Madd Dogg Henry Heeler storms into the ring, his usual calm demeanor replaced with unrestrained fury. He grabs a microphone, his hands shaking—not with fear, but with pure rage. The crowd roars in anticipation as Henry paces the ring, his voice booming when he speaks.]

‘Madd Dogg’ Henry Heeler: "Ozzy Dethstrike! Bully Raymond! You’ve both made the biggest mistakes of your lives! Ozzy, you think holding that Grand Prix Championship makes you untouchable? You think parading around with a title you don’t deserve makes you a king? Let me make this clear—you’re nothing but a placeholder. That championship isn’t yours. It’s MINE!"

[Heeler’s voice grows louder, his rage barely contained as he grips the ropes, pointing toward the camera with hate in his words.]

‘Madd Dogg’ Henry Heeler: "And Bully Raymond... You couldn’t just stay out of it, could you? No, you had to stick your nose in my business, distract me, and cost me the X-1 Championship—the championship I bled for, fought for, and turned into the most prestigious title in this company! You think you’re clever, don’t you? Well, let me tell you something—you’ve just signed up for a world of pain you’re not ready for!"

[The crowd barks like dogs in acceptance as Heeler paces, his intensity growing with every step.]

‘Madd Dogg’ Henry Heeler: "I’m done playing nice. I’ve been the calm one, the strategist, the level-headed competitor. But that’s over. You took everything from me, and now, I’m going to take everything from you. Ozzy, until I get my rematch, no one—and I mean NO ONE—has the right to challenge you. That championship belongs to me, and you’re just keeping it warm."

[He stops mid-ring, his voice dropping to an ominous growl as he stares into the camera.]

‘Madd Dogg’ Henry Heeler: "Bully, you wanted my attention? Congratulations—you’ve got it. I’m going to tear through you first, and then I’m coming for Ozzy. And when I take back what’s mine, I’ll make sure neither of you ever forget the name Madd Dogg Henry Heeler. You’ve both unleashed something you can’t control, and there’s no turning back now."

[He tosses the microphone to the mat with a thunderous crack as his music blares through the arena. Heeler storms out of the ring, shoving past security as the crowd begins to bark like dogs again, the fury in his eyes leaving no doubt that the Madd Dogg has truly been unleashed.]



#233-TV CHAMPION / LEAGUE TAG-TEAM CHAMPION / TV 6-MAN CHAMPION



[The screen fades to black. The arena hushes. A haunting, gravelly voice emerges from the darkness, resonating as if from the echoes of time itself. It's a voice laden with wisdom, reverence, and a subtle undercurrent of skepticism. The crowd grows silent, drawn into the weight of the words.]

Voice: "Once... there was chaos. A League divided, a battleground where alliances crumbled under the weight of ambition and betrayal. But amidst the ruin, three names rose like pillars, unshaken, unyielding—the Dogg House Crew. Rusty Chains, Madd Dogg Henry Heeler, and Arcane. Three warriors, bound not by blood, but by battle. Together, they forged a legacy. Domination became their creed. Championships, their spoils. And the League... their territory."

[The voice pauses, its tone dipping into something sharper, more reflective.]

Voice: "Yet even the mightiest foundation can crack. Rusty Chains—the wild card, the brawler, the indomitable force who answers no master. He challenges anyone, anywhere, turning obstacles into stepping stones for his rise. But does he fight for the Crew... or for himself? His victories are undeniable, yet his independence casts a long shadow. The question is: where does his path truly lead?"

[The voice sharpens further, as if pointing a blade at the next topic.]

Voice: "Arcane, the calculating tactician. Feared for his brilliance in the ring and his ability to dissect any opponent. He stands now at the precipice of a new war—a bitter rivalry with Magnum T-Eh, a man who wields his Canadian pride as a weapon of deceit. Arcane thrives on precision, but can he overcome a foe who thrives on dishonor? And will his pursuit of vindication for himself eclipse the mission of the Crew?"

[There is a subtle shift in tone—weightier, darker. The voice grows quieter but somehow more imposing.]

Voice: "And then... there's Madd Dogg Henry Heeler. The once-calm general of the Crew, the mentor, the strategist. But that man is gone. In his place stands a beast fueled by rage, unrelenting in his quest for vengeance. Ozzy Dethstrike holds the championship that Madd Dogg built with his blood and his sweat. And Bully Raymond? A mere distraction that cost him his crown. Now, Henry doesn't just fight for gold—he fights to tear down the very fabric of the League that wronged him. But rage is a double-edged sword. Will it lead him to triumph... or to ruin?"

[The voice softens momentarily, almost as if lamenting.]

Voice: "The Dogg House Crew is united by history, forged in battle. They've stood atop the League as champions, as warriors, as legends. Yet the paths they walk now twist and diverge. Rusty seeks freedom, Arcane seeks precision, Henry seeks vengeance. They are bound together, yet pulled apart by the weight of their ambitions."

[The voice shifts, gaining an edge of urgency, as if issuing a warning.]

Voice: "The Dogg House Crew has dominated before. But domination comes with a price. The League waits. Rivals sharpen their blades. And the question remains: will they rise again, stronger than ever? Or will their separate battles be their undoing?"

[The screen flickers with the shadows of the three men, standing together yet isolated in their resolve. The voice delivers its final words, heavy and deliberate.]

Voice: "Dogg House Crew, your legacy is unmatched... but your future remains uncertain. The League watches. The world watches. And the time has come to decide—not as individuals, but as a united force. Will you stand together once more... or fall apart under the weight of your own fire?"

[The screen fades to black. The crowd sits in stunned silence as the echoes of the voice linger in the air.]
