The New PWI

Welcome to the new era of Pro Wrestling Imitated (PWI) v2.0. Actually, it's more like v3.0 for those that are keeping score, but who's counting? You know what they say - if you're not changing, then you're not growing!

For the past 2-years, the ASL + RDL have served as the foundation of PWI, primarily centered around a few shared PPVs throughout the year. Well, I'm here to announce that we've struck a deal - 2 deals to be precise - that will grow our brand significantly and open up a whole new world of possibilities!

Beginning next cycle, the PWI brand will officially include the Xtreme Poison League (XPL) in the Iron Federation as well as the legendary Lone Wolf League (LWL) from the Jade Federation expanding our new lineup to:

XPL (Iron) // ASL (Gold) // RDL (Bronze) // LWL (Jade)

Under this new arrangement, every league under the PWI banner will join together for 4x PPV events throughout the year. Additionally, this alliance provisions for the creation of a PWI Universal Champion as well as a PWI Universal Tag Team Champion! Once established, these titles will be defended every other cycle on a rotating basis between the leagues as well as at each joint PPV event for a total of 12 title defenses throughout the year! Also, helping these titles to stand out from the rest, a 5 point bonus will be awarded to the champion and/or challenger whenever they submit a title match promo to the league in which they are being defended, adding a little trash talk bonus for those leagues.

Aside from the items noted above, the changes you see to any of the four leagues involved will be subtle as there's no requirement for the Commissioners of these leagues to do anything different. So, while it should continue to be business as usual, our hope is that this newly formed alliance will add a spark of comradery and boost of energy to each of the leagues and their players.

Thanks to everyone who already participates in one or more of these leagues and we look forward to welcoming those who are on their way. Good luck to each of you and stay tuned for more details in the coming cycles!

Royal Rumble

30+ superstars from across all PWI promotions compete in an over the top Royal Rumble. The winner earns a shot at the PWI Universal Title at King of the Ring.

Money in the Bank

Each league sends 3x representatives of their choosing to compete in a special MITB match. The winner earns a contract that they can use to cash in for a shot at any title in the entire PWI of their choosing over the next 12-months. Title matches must be disclosed to the Commissioner prior to any score calculation that would be used for the match. Special handicaps will be applied to various scenarios.

Additionally, at this PPV a tag team title contenders tournament will be held for a shot at the Universal Tag Titles at Survivor Series.

KOTR

Each PWI promotion holds qualifier matches prior to the PPV and sends 4 wrestlers to the PPV tournament. 16 wrestlers in total fight it out to become the PWI King of the Ring and earn a shot at the PWI Universal Title at Money in the Bank.

Survivor Series

Each league will coordinate 2x four-on-four Survivor Series matchups that will utilize special scoring to determine the survivors. Next, the survivors from each match will compete in a Sole Survivor free-for-all in which the winner will earn a PWI Universal Title shot at the Royal Rumble.

Additionally, a tag team Survivor Series battle royal will be held. Each league will send one team to compete in an over the top battle royal using combined singles scores. When a wrestler is eliminated, so is his partner! The last team standing earns a shot at the PWI Universal Tag Team Titles at the Royal Rumble in a match that will use singles scores to determine the winner!

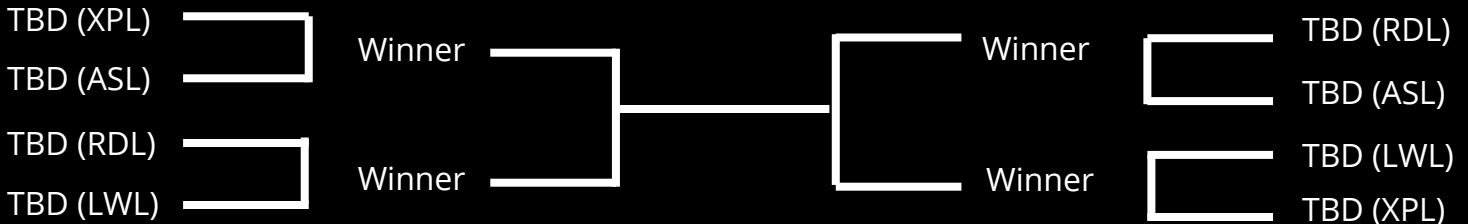

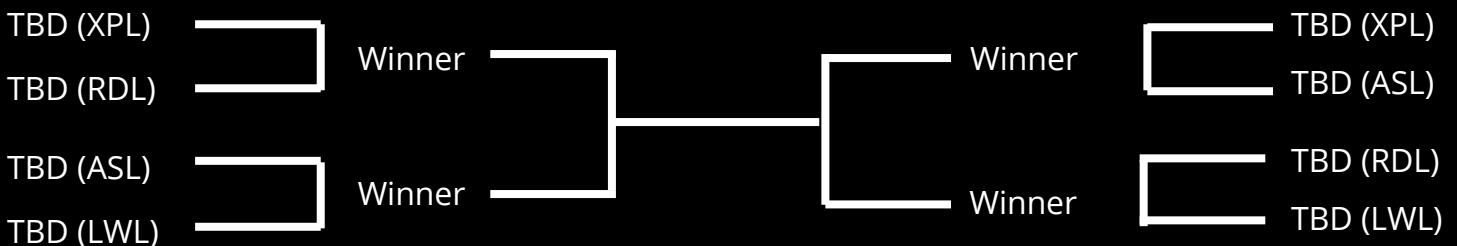
PWI UNIVERSAL TITLE TOURNAMENT

A briefcase full of cash and a contract will be suspended 20 feet above the ring. The first wrestler to retrieve the briefcase is declared the winner, winning \$100,000 and a contract that guarantees him one (1) shot at any Commissioner's Title in the entire PWI.

The contract can be cashed-in at any time of the winner's choosing within a 12-month period provided that it's communicated to the Commissioner prior to the Iron of that cycle.

The person cashing-in the contract automatically receives a 2 point handicap in the title match due to the element of surprise. The defending champion will also receive an additional 1 point deduction for each opponent he has already faced that night.
